## **Rebates**

The Landscape Survey Program is a survey performed on your existing landscape and irrigation system and is the pre-qualifier for the Landscape Rebate Program. The Landscape Rebate Program provides rebates for irrigation hardware upgrades and the replacement of qualifying high water use plants with approved water efficient landscaping. Rebates are paid on a first-come, first-serve basis and are available until funds are depleted or until June 30, 2012, whichever comes first.

**Do not begin your project until you have received a written notice to proceed from the water district.**

<b>Commercial Property Landscape Conversion Rebate Amounts</b>	
<u>Non Cost Sharing Cities</u> \$0.75 per sq ft	Maximum rebate of \$20,000
<u>Cost Sharing Cities* (Cities Contributing to a Portion of the Conversion)</u> \$1.50 per sq ft for first 13,333 converted sq ft \$0.75 per sq ft for any remaining sq ft	Maximum rebate of \$30,000

<b>Qualifying Irrigation Equipment and Rebate Amounts</b>	
Rain Sensor	Up to \$50 per sensor
High Efficiency Nozzles	Up to \$5 per nozzle
Dedicated Landscape Meter	Up to \$500 per meter
Rotary Sprinklers or Spray Bodies with Pressure Regulation and/or Check Valves	Up to \$20 per set
Weather Based Irrigation Controller, 1-12 Stations	Up to \$300 per controller
Weather-Based Irrigation Controller, 13-24 Stations	Up to \$700 per controller
Weather-Based Irrigation Controller, 25 Stations Or Greater	Up to \$1,000 per controller

- Weather Based Irrigation Controllers and High Efficiency Nozzles must be on SCVWD approved list and controllers must be installed with a rain sensor unless otherwise noted.
